



Drop Off

Registration and Check In

Drop off begins at 7:30am and runs until 9:30am, with breakfast being served until 8:30am.

Once you have signed your child in you will need to choose their sandwich filling (if they are having a standard camp lunch). Please also ensure any medication is given to the Camp staff at this time also.

This is also an opportunity to give in any money for the tuck shop (information of which can be found in this guide) to be kept safe my the venue manager who will wrote down your child's name and ensure they are called to the tuck shop later in the day.

Once your child is signed in the staff will collect them from the drop off area and take them to their base area for the day where they will meet their camp staff.

Collection Collection Times & Security

Collection for the standard day session is from 3:30pm-4:30pm with the late session extending until 6pm which must be booked in advance.

When arriving to collect your child please give the manager your child's name and the Camp Staff will bring them to the collection area. Management may ask for some details to confirm your identity before releasing the child i.e. your first name or collection password.

If someone else is going to be collecting your child please ensure you have added them to the collectors on your account and that they are aware of the collection password.

Please avoid dropping off or collecting your child between the hours of 9:30am-3:30pm as all staff will be busy engaging the children in activities . If you need to do so please arrange this with the camp manager.



Unable to attend?

If you are unable to attend please amend or cancel your booked days via your account.

For credit to be applied you must provide 48 hours notice of your absence. Where this is not possible such as illness on the day of your booking, please contact a member of the venue or office team.



First Aid

First Aid & Mediation

Every Venue Manager is Paediatric
First Aid and Autoinjector trained. With
many of our camp staff holding other
first aid qualifications. This means there
is always someone first aid trained on
hand to look after your child if they are
unwell or injured.

Prescribed medication must be handed to the venue manager at the beginning of the day and you must have completed the medication form on your child's account. The manager will then administer the medication at your specified time and notify you of this on collection.

EYFS

Your Child's keyworker

As part of our OFSTED registration we have a strong focus on the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS).

Your child's keyworker's for the day will be the 2 staff members assigned to their group. The EYFS children in the group will be paid special attention throughout the day to ensure they are safe, happy and having fun!

When delivering activities our staff will be using the 7 Early Learning Goals to ensure activities promote development, engage and excite our 4 and 5 year olds.



Nut Policy

Our Policy on Nuts

Kidz Camp Essex has a strict no nuts policy, meaning no products that contain, may contain or have traces of nuts are permitted to be consumed within our venues.

Please ensure anything homemade or not in it's original packaging has an ingredients list clearly attached.

Anything that is found to have traces of nuts will not be able to be consumed at the venue but will be given back to the child to take home with them.





Lunches

Camp Lunches

Children attending camp have the option of bringing a packed lunch, purchasing a premium lunch or having the free camp lunch. The free camp lunch includes a sandwich with cheese, jam or hamwhich you will select at drop off, crisps, raisins and a biscuit.

If your child has dietary requirements please ensure you have informed us of these via your online account- please note while we have options available to meet some dietary requirements but if your child requires gluten free bread for example this will need to be brought in or a packed lunch supplied.

You can upgrade to the premium lunch option for £4.50 per child, per day- this includes a sandwich with a choice of filling (jam, ham, cheese, tuna or cream cheese) crisps, yoghurt, chocolate biscuit bar, piece of fruit and a children's juice drink.

What Not to Bring

- Electronic devices such as mobile phones or smart watches
- ✓ Valuable or sentimental items
- Products containing Nuts (Please see our Nut Policy)
- Toys or games from home- these could get lost or broken
- Non prescribed medicines- we cannot administer these at camp.

What to Bring

- ✓ Weather appropriate clothing
- A named refillable water bottle
- Snacks and a packed lunch (if not having a camp lunch)
- On water fun days- swimwear and a towel
- Any prescribed medication
- Spare clothes for little ones
- In warm weather- sun cream, applied before arrival and supplied in their bag to be topped up during the day.

 (Venues have a small amount of hypoallergenic SPF50 sun cream they can use unless you tell us otherwise.

For water fun days your child will need swimwear or clothes they can get wet in such as a spare t-shirt/shorts and a towel. If your child is attending our Southend venue; your child may wish to bring goggles etc as the venue has a swimming pool. We have plenty of floats and buoyancy aids available and the swim session is always supervised by our camp staff and a qualified lifeguard. Every venue will take part in our water fight and games, slip and slide and crowd favourite... soak the coach!
